	• To carry out cleaning of allocated area(s), • Frequency of cleaning to be undertaken as directed by Procedure Codes. • To carry out as necessary the replacement to roller towels, renewing supply of toilet rolls and replacement of bin liners. • To assist as necessary with the cleaning up after break-in or vandalism at the school. • In emergency situations to assist with the clearing of snow and ice from paths and entries. • To undertake training in the correct use of cleaning equipment such as floor machines, Vacs, wets pick-ups and in health and safety and the use of cleaning chemicals. • To notify the Site Manager or other member of the site team, of any damage to buildings and equipment or of anything you see that may be dangerous to pupils and/or staff. • Such other duties relating to the cleanliness of the school premises as may be necessary from time to time within the reasonable requirements of the Headteacher and Governing Body.
